It sounds simple but it is one of the more difficult studies one can do, but is simple reinforcement of fundamental skills such as shape, values, composition, color and space. It is often preferred of many teachers as a pre requisite to portrait painting because of the various nuances it teaches in transitions of color without extreme value changes. It has always been a favorite of my students.</p>

The components of this versatile block are the starting point for hundreds of traditional and modern quilt designs. You'll learn an innovative technique for quickly and accurately making the blocks, and we'll explore a variety of layout and design options. In addition, you'll learn basic quilt techniques, including cutting with rulers, using rotary cutters, proper ¼" seams, basting, quilting and binding. You can finish your project into a mini-quilt wallhanging or a 16" throw pillow. Note: This class is most appropriate for people with basic sewing skills. If you are very new to sewing, you may need to do some homework to finish the project within the allotted time.</p>

You will sew coiled baskets constructed of cotton rope and gain extensive experience with a zig-zag stitch. Over the course of three weeks, you will make your own coiled pieces to take home with granted design freedom. Products may include: coasters, trivets, trays, baskets, totes and handbags, in unisex designs!</p>
