<p>Tuesday April 23-May 14 6:00-9:00pm Round Room Tyler Griese</p>	<p>Glazing Techniques in Oil Painting: Learn the Techniques of the Old Masters Buy Now \$60</p> <p>Learn how to utilize one of oldest techniques in oil painting. You will be empowered to use the painting techniques of artists such as Van Eyck, Rembrandt, and Vermeer. You will be able to create paintings with luminosity and richness of color. In this course we will cover the techniques of Glazing, Scumbling, and Velatura. We will begin the course by learning how to begin a painting with a grisaille (tonal underpainting) oil painting and build transparent layers of paint in order to allow you to create a finished painting with the same techniques of the old masters. Your finished painting will evoke a mood in a manner similar to the paintings made in the 15th-18th centuries and beyond. This course will provide you a skill in which you can use to further influence your conceptual practice of painting.</p>
